FOUND POETRY CHALLENGE

- Each poem must be 14 or fewer lines.
- You may give it your own original title if you like. <u>The title</u>
 <u>does not count as one of the lines.</u>
- Your sole source material must be from Maine published newspaper or magazine articles. You can use up to two articles.
 They do not need to come from the same publication.
- The poem itself should use no more than two of your own words. The rest of the words and phrases can be mixed up any way you like, but should all come from the article(s) you have chosen. (You may repeat words from the articles as many times as you like.)
- -You may change:

verb tenses punctuation and/or capitalization plural to singular and vice versa

- Poems may be submitted by groups or by individuals. You may submit up to three poems.

The title and the name of the magazine or newspaper

The date of each publication and its page number

The name of the original author
