Foam:

Could be purchased at JoAnn's Fabrics, ordered on-line, etc. There are other types of fancier mats, but this is fine.

Wool roving:

Many types of wool are good for needle felting, but Corriedale is one of the best. Bartlett Yarns is a Maine source. Their wool tends to be heathery.

There are many other sources for more solid colors.

Eves:

Lyn has a variety of glass eyes if people would like to purchase them. The eyes could be also be felted.

Flat needle felting:

Some people might like to try 2D needle felting to make pictures. Lyn has some small pieces of flat wool felt for this purpose.
